Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and name, address, and other personal information • Medical and employment information • Account balances, account transactions, and payment history <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons OneBridge Benefits Inc. chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does OneBridge Benefits Inc. protect my personal information?	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect your nonpublic personal information, including restrictions on access to your confidential information.</p>
How does OneBridge Benefits Inc. collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account or make deposits to or withdrawals from your account • Use your debit card • Use our web site • Give us your contact or employment information <p>We may also collect your personal information from others, such as your employer, the Social Security Administration, and public records to comply with government requirements to know our customers.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

Definitions

Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our affiliate is OneBridge Agency LLC, a nonfinancial company.
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • OneBridge Benefits Inc. does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • OneBridge Benefits Inc. does not engage in any joint marketing.
